#### ANALYTICAL CUBISM Workshop

Analytical Cubism is viewing something or someone from multiple viewpoints and basically drawing the person or thing over and over on top of itself until you get lots of lines of the same object but from different viewpoints overlapping each other.

## Upcoming LGAA workshop

### Beginning Portraiture with Judy Gelfert

Learn the art of portraiture with artist Judy Gelfert. In this workshop, Judy will reveal the secrets of drawing and painting portraits by breaking down a seemingly difficult subject into more easily understood concepts. We will learn the general shapes and dimensions of the human head and features and will learn about capturing likeness by concentrating on the fundamentals of oil painting, including shapes, values, color intensity and neutrals, and paint application and manipulation. Judy will do a demonstration to begin the workshop, and students will then paint a portrait of their choosing from their own photograph or one of Judy's. Students will receive individual attention throughout the workshop.
